The camping is done, depending on the season and the weather, in tents, fishing huts, houses of the population from local communities, consuming traditional local products

We explore from kayaks or canoes the course of the navigable Danube, Borcea Branch, Măcin, Vâlcu and along the numerous canals, islands, swampy areas, flooded ponds, lakes of a special wilderness, specific to meadow areas and nature reserve. We present localities along the shores, specific local communities with a special authenticity, natural and anthropic tourist objectives and even mountains. The effort is to develop specific tourism programs in these somewhat isolated areas to be better known.
